- Market Lambs must attend a weigh-in and meet scrapie tag requirements.
- Market Goats must attend a weigh-in and meet scrapie tag requirements.
- Market Hogs must attend weigh-in.

**Tagging** - Due to an increased cost, each 4-Her is allowed the following FREE ear tags:

**2 FREE tags per 4-Her, per specie.** Additional tags will be sold at a cost of \$2.25.

If you plan to exhibit a market animal at the Kansas State Fair or the Kansas Jr. Livestock Show, you MUST use electronic ear tags and complete the nomination process of DNA collection. EID tags & DNA Envelopes available at the Extension Office.


