(1000 ewes and lamb feed yard)

3rd stop approximately 2:00 p.m.
at Bob Price Farm, Deerfield
(6-800 hair ewes, lower input, pasture)

Final stop approximately 4:15 p.m. at
Ron Gibson Farm, Copeland
(6-800 hair ewes, irrigated grass,
crop residue)

Light supper available at Gibson's
after tour provided by Western KS
Sheep Producers.
